The Cummings Campus is conveniently situated across the road from the Hugonote Kollege Main Building in College Street located in Wellington.

The campus consists of 4 different hostels:

1. Interim
2. Bungalow
3. Ark
4. Whitehouse

The Stoneman library below is also situated on the Cummings campus which makes it safe and easily accessible after hours for study and research. It also has an IT lab with 15 computers on the 1st floor.



The Ferguson Hall below left is an Academic block where the Social Work degree lecturers and most Supervisors are based for supervision sessions. There are often classes offered in Ferguson. Students are allowed access after hours to create more study areas for examination preparation.



Interim: Consists of 36 beds with both double and single rooms available located next to the library.



Ark: Consists of 18 single rooms and is located directly behind the Ferguson Hall.





Bungalow: Consists of a house with 11 beds (single and double available). It is located opposite the library and next to the Ferguson Hall.



Whitehouse: Consists of two units (A block and B block) with 33 single rooms each and is located next to the netball and tennis courts.



All hostels are equipped with microwaves, washing machines, television, fridge / freezer that students can use on a booking system.

The Hugonote Kollege staff from the Cleaning services department are responsible for cleaning all the communal areas such as the bathrooms, kitchens and passages. Students are responsible for the cleanliness of their own rooms. Room Inspections are arranged during the academic term.

The House Committee is elected every year and is responsible to maintain a balanced academic and social life on the campus. All members undergo 1st Aid and Fire warden training and act as first responders to any emergency situations that may occur. They play a crucial role in liaising between students and the Resident Head.
